- ❖ **Expert Talks on the "Significance of Inculcating Art in Teacher Education"** by P T Narendra Menon, Advocate and Lyricist and Smt. Sukumari Narendra Menon, carnatic musician and visiting Professor of Kerala Kalamandalam for batch 2023-2025 was conducted on 16th August 2023. To recognize the role of art in education by promoting artistic literacy and creative thinking skills of the student teachers and to analyse and interpret the work of art considering factors such as historical context, cultural significance and artistic intent and its application in the teaching learning environment.
